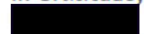
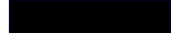
Team,

Following recent exchanges via email, phone calls, texts, and virtual meetings between Victor and myself, it's evident that I no longer have a place within the new BVN leadership. While I had aimed to address my concerns during today's Executive meeting, with the inclusion of a third party, Tom Borcky, to seek resolution, this meeting has been canceled in favor of an emergency board meeting. Notably, as an officer of the organization, I have not been informed of nor invited to this meeting. This omission leads me to assume it's an attempt to unilaterally remove me from the decision making process within our organization.

Attached, you'll find my resignation letter. Accordingly, I will promptly hand over all BVN files, delete BVN Google profiles and data from my computer, and facilitate the turnover of BVN inventory stored in my home by June 15, 2024. I've already been compensated for May 1-15. Therefore, I'll spend today and tomorrow closing my Chase account and organizing any outstanding documents on Google Drive.

Given recent behavior and decisions, I don't feel secure providing a two-week notice and staying on board to assist with turnover at this time. My well-being doesn't seem to be a priority to our CEO, as indicated by recent actions detailed in my attached letter. Furthermore, I request that my resignation letter be treated as a formal complaint in accordance with BVN Bylaws.
